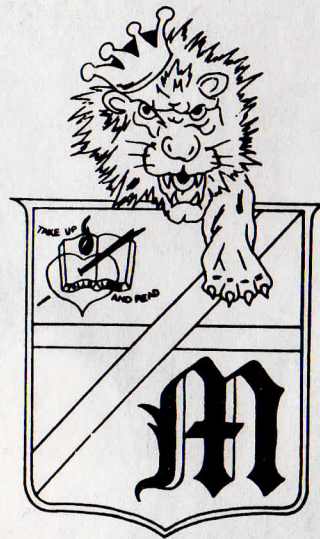

Rev. Joseph G. Stobba Celebrates 25th Anniversary

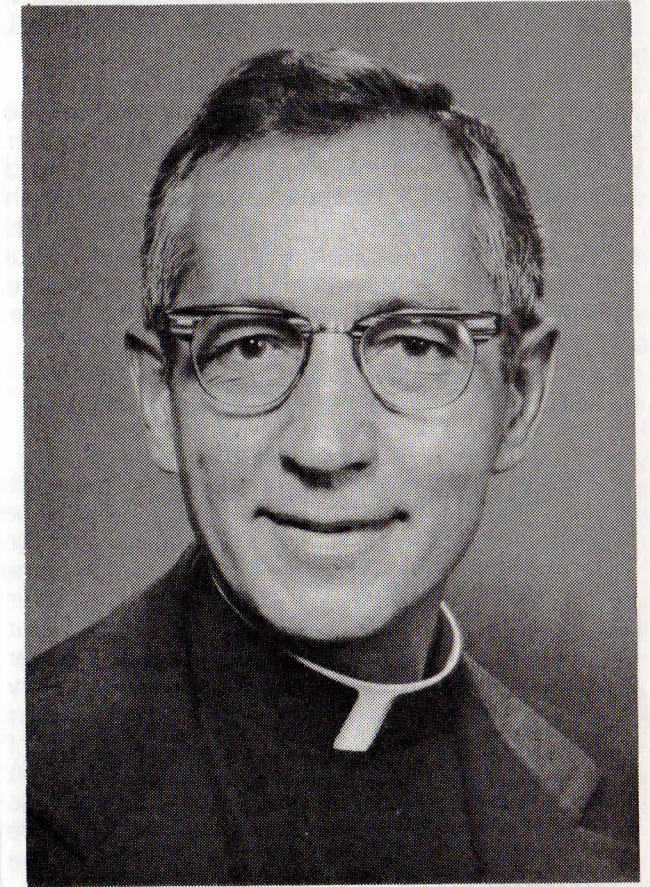
The Reverend Joseph G. Stobba, O.S.A., Principal of Mendel Catholic High School, will celebrate a Mass of Thanksgiving with his family and friends to mark his 25th Anniversary of Priesthood on Sunday, May 27th in the Mendel Chapel at 2:00 P.M. A reception will follow immediately on the school campus.

Father Stobba attended St. Rita elementary school, Chicago; St. Augustine High School Seminary, Holland, Michigan; St. Monica Novitiate, Oconomowoc, Wisconsin; Villanova University from which he received Bachelor of Arts and Master of Science degrees; Augustinian College, Washington, D.C. for theological studies and DePaul University, Chicago, from which he received a Master of Education degree.

During his 25 years of Priesthood, he has served 11 years at Mendel as teacher, counselor, librarian and principal. Meanwhile, he assisted on weekends at Holy Name of Mary, St. Margaret of Scotland and St. John Fisher Parishes. Other years of priestly ministry were at St. Augustine High School Seminary, Holland, Michigan as teacher, librarian, rector and principal, Tolentine Center, Olympia Fields, Il. as Executive Director for Research and Planning, and at St. John Stone Friary, Hyde Park as Provincial Secretary and Formation Team member. Since 1973, he has conducted summer retreats for religious.

On Sunday, June 3, St. John Fisher Parish, where Father has assisted since 1971, will commemorate his anniversary with a Concelebrated Mass followed by a reception in Kane Hall. The homily will be delivered by Msgr. Francis McElligott, Pastor Emeritus.

Father Stobba will make a study-pilgrimage to the Holy Land and Rome this summer under the auspices of the Archdiocesan Center for Pastoral Ministry.

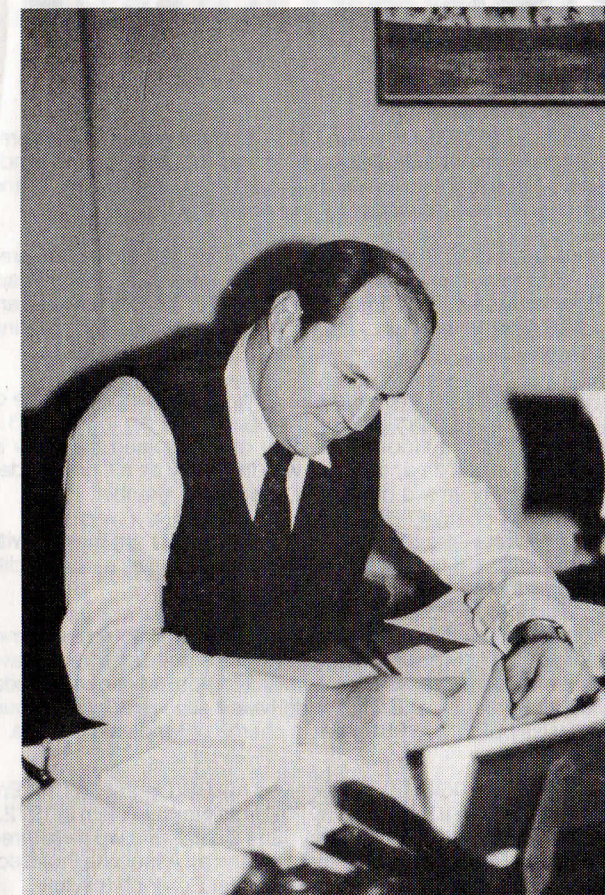

Alumni Profiles...

The following interview was conducted by Michael Coburn, of the Class of 1985 at Office of the Cook County Tax Assessor.

What has been your educational background?

I went to Christ the King Grammar school and entered Mendel Catholic High School in 1957. After graduating in 1961, I attended Xavier University in Cincinnati, Ohio. I majored in economics, political science and philosophy. When I received my degree from Xavier, I opted to go to Ohio State University on a scholarship in pursuit of a Master's Degree in Economics. Thereafter, I attended the DePaul School of Law from 1967 to 1970, receiving my J.D. Degree. After I passed the Bar Exam in March of 1970, I practiced Law in private practice. I also got married.

What is your view of politics and public service?

When Brother Krol was here last time, we had a long talk about that. That question is probably the heart of our whole democratic society. The political structure is necessary. We have to have it. In a democracy, it's the key to the very foundation of our

governmental system here, and of any free society. The political structure is the way we register our needs and wants, from the governmental annex. Therefore, that process has to be an open and free process. Politics that are connected with public service are kind of misinterpreted today. Politics always brings a negative connotations, and it is not.

Politics involve people registering needs together. Common interest groups are able to assert their desires on those people who are in public service. I have been in public service since I graduated from Law School, and I think it is one of the highest honors anyone can pay to society. Because you have within your grasp, the power to affect people's lives and you try to do the best you can to help them. That's the key, it's the key to serving in public office. You have to be dedicated to the common good. I think that is the thing that keeps people in it. They feel as though they can help people. I know that's what has kept me into it. Hopefully, as a Judge, I'll get a chance to fulfill that role even more than I do now.

What are your plans for the future?

I'm currently on the ballot for the Democratic Party. I have been fortunate enough to have been slated for the Circuit Court of Cook County, becoming the nominee in the March Primary. Now, I will go to the general election in the Fall. If the people in their wisdom decide I am going to be the Proper candidate, I will be elected to that Office in 1984. It will be interesting to see how that comes out.

Do you have any other interests besides your political life?

My family. I have three children, and a wife. Most of my non-office time is spent with my family. My children are all in school, and they are all active in athletics. You have to do a lot of things to keep your home life together, especially when you are in public service, because it is so time consuming. The time you do spend at home becomes precious. As far as other interests are concerned, I take a special interest in social projects. I was the Master of Ceremonies for our 20th Year Class Reunion for Mendel a couple of years back. That required about a year to put together. That was a very stimulating project. We were constantly in and out of the school. This brought back memories. We were comparing it to when we were going to school. We thoroughly enjoyed it. But I've been involved in all sorts of activities. Hopefully, the committee will see fit to have me as the 25th year Master of Ceremonies.

Thank you for your time.

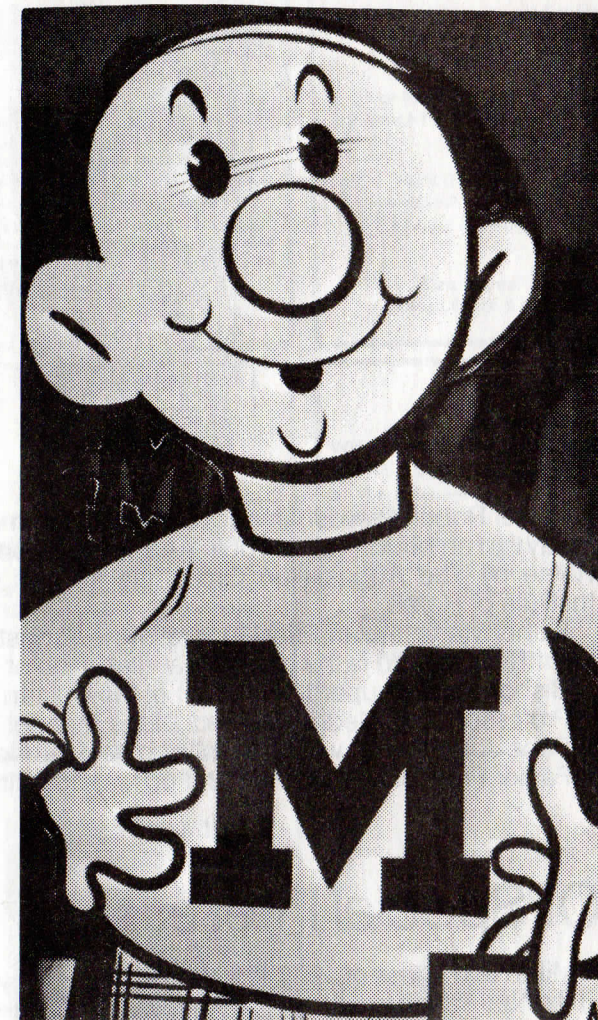

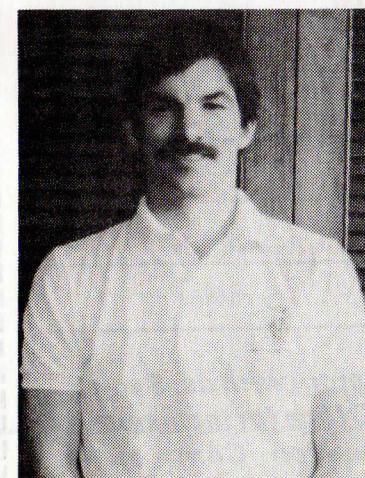

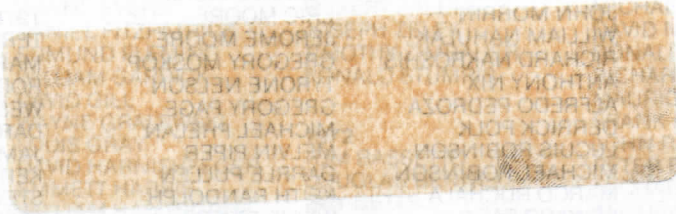
