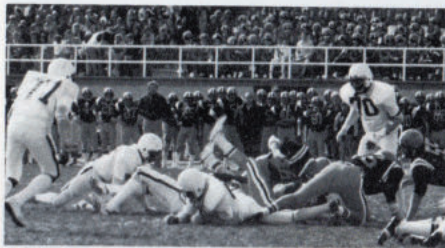

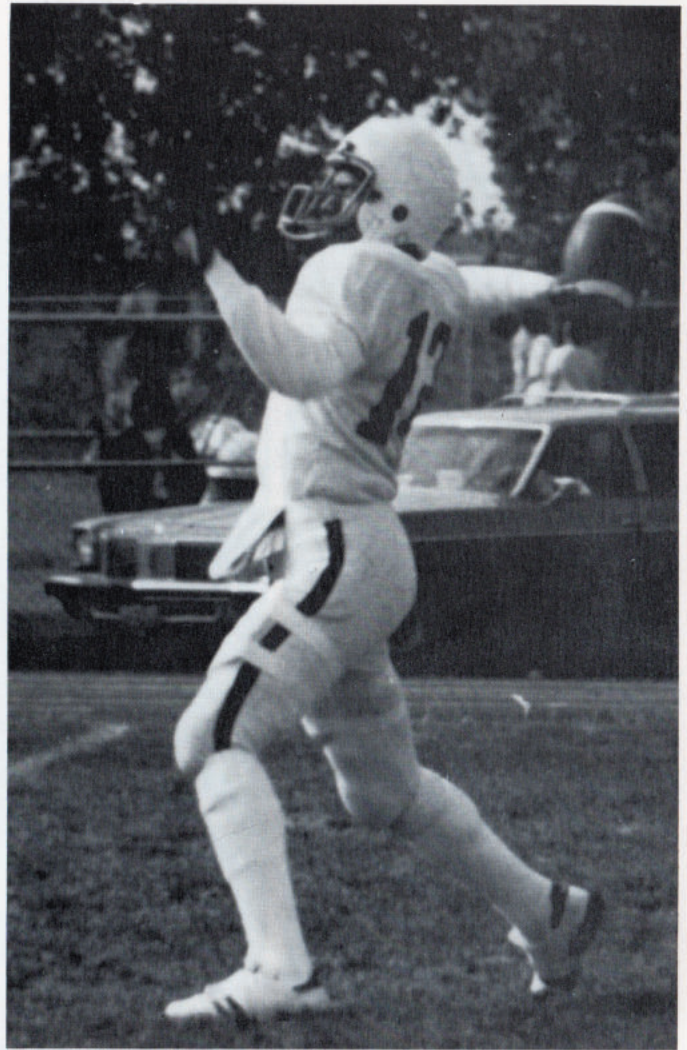

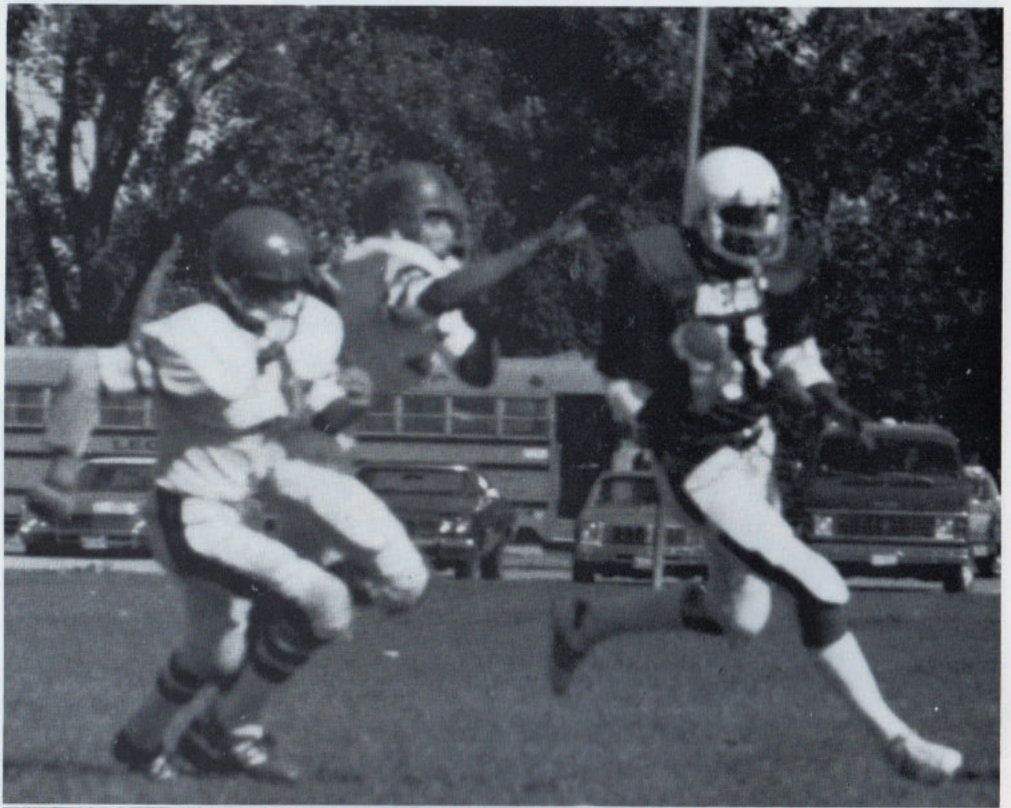

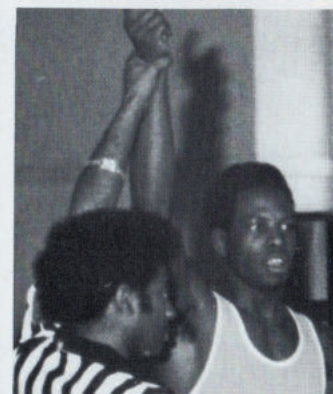


Monarchs Do Well in City Finals
