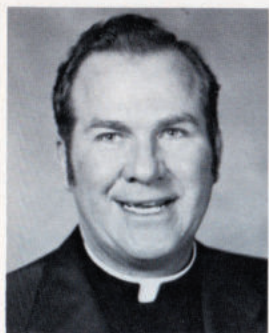
Let us pray for each other and continue to emphasize the values and attitudes that recognize that God is Number One in the Mendel Family.

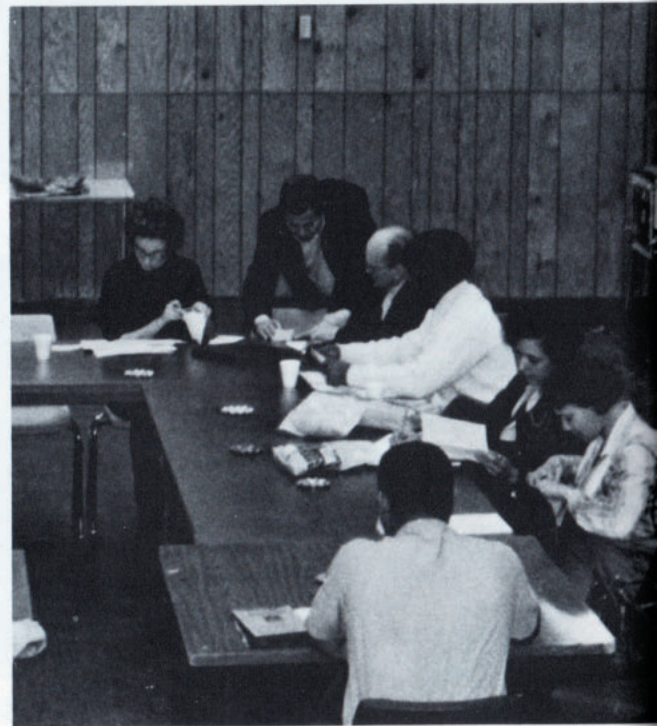
Parents' Club in Action

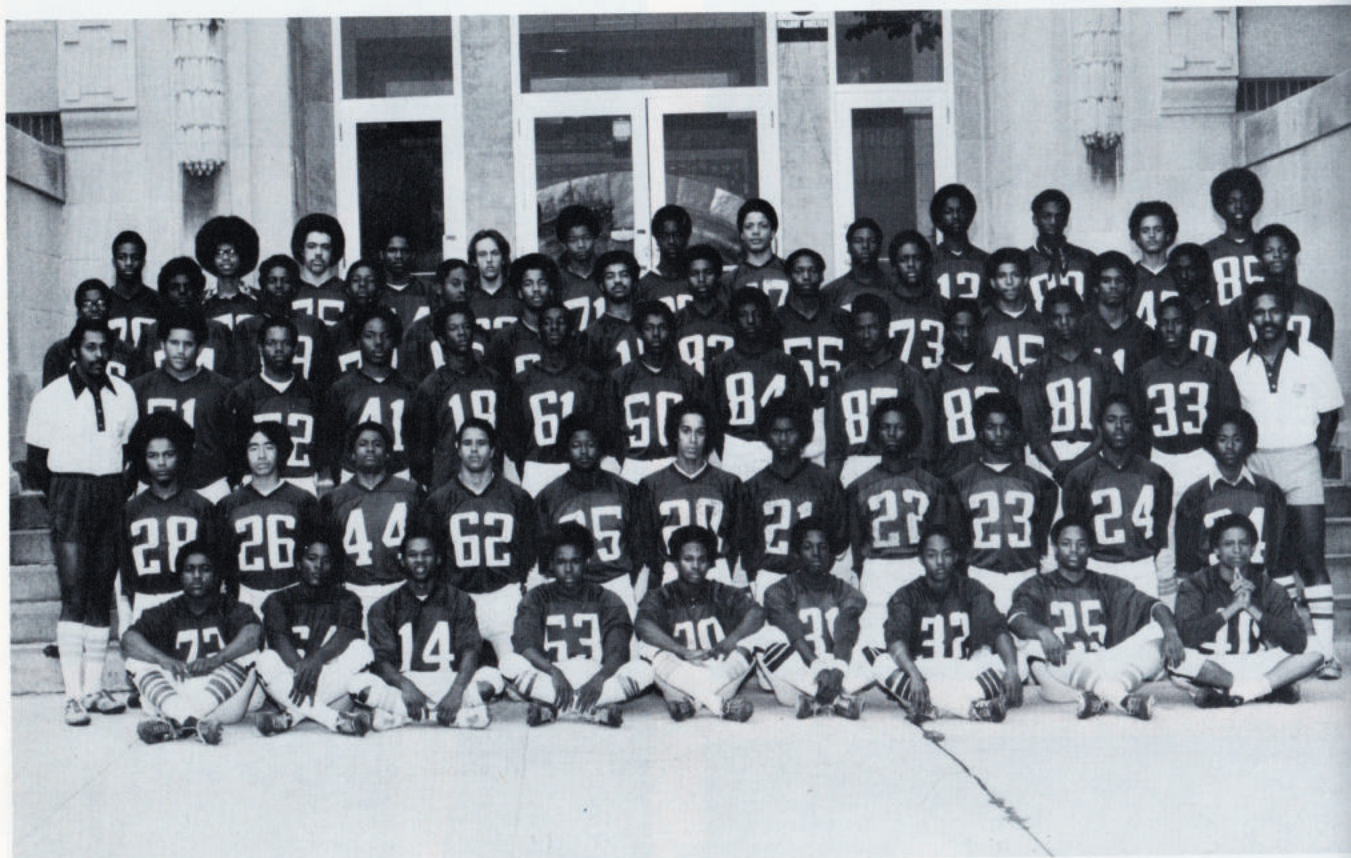

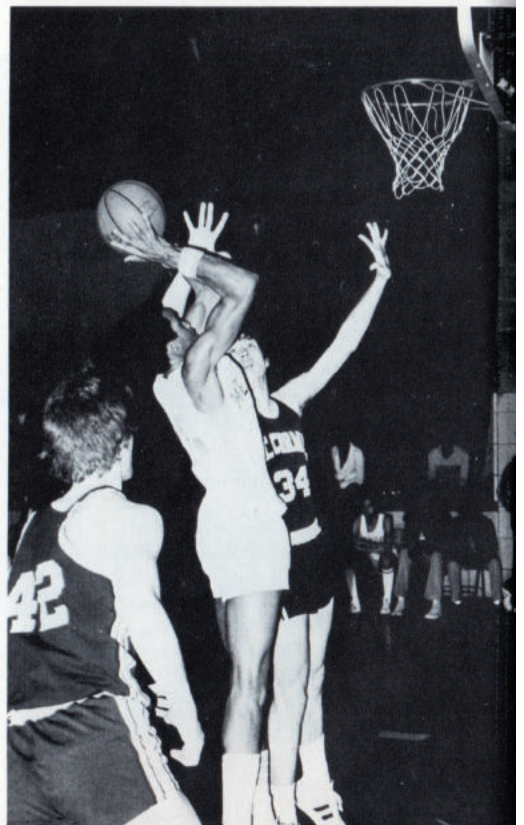




Monarchs Finish 3rd in the Chicago Catholic League

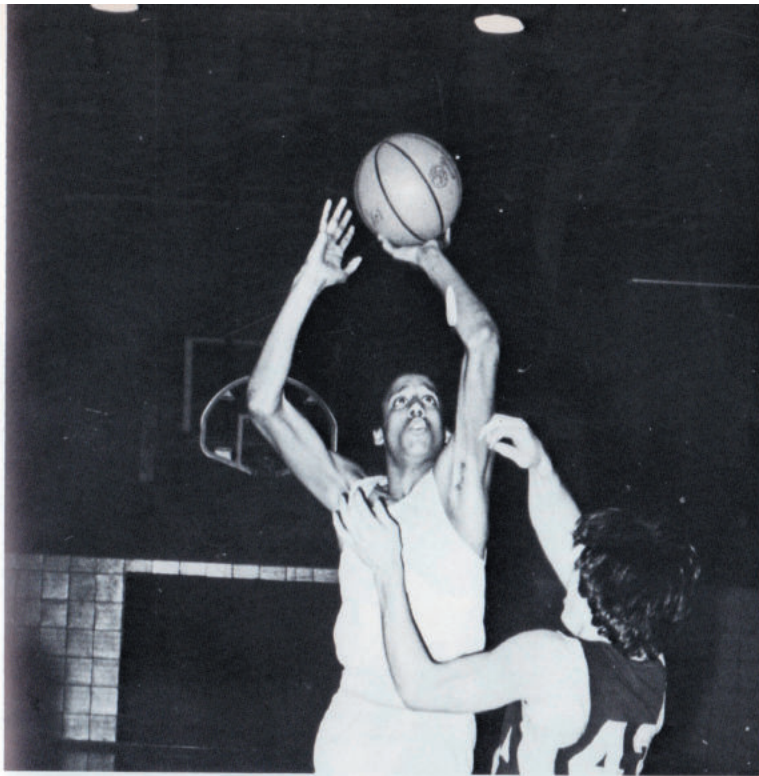

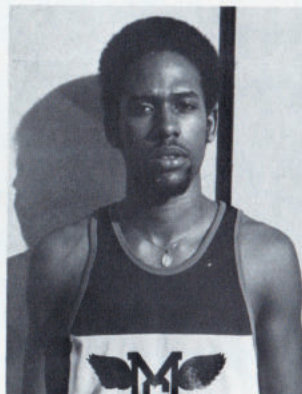
