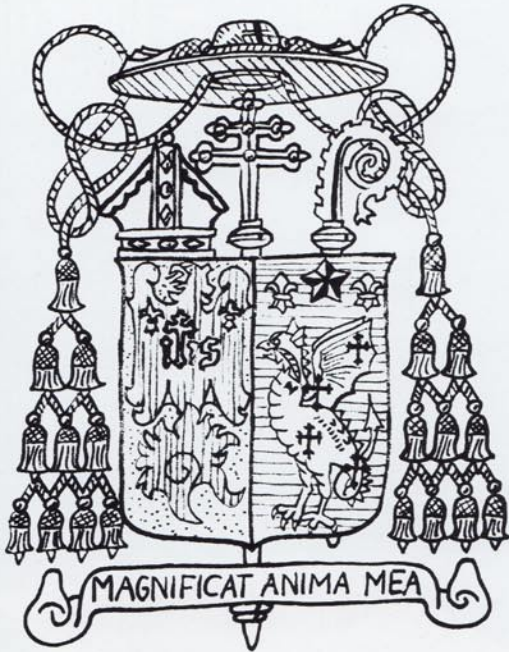


Rev. John L. Seary O.S.A.

Father Daniel Hartigan's entire priestly life has been one of service and dedication to the Augustinian Order. After his ordination to the priesthood in May of 1945, he served on the faculty at St. Rita High School for five years. In 1951 Father Hartigan was assigned to the first faculty of the newly established Mendel Catholic High School, and, for the next ten years, he was both teacher and part-time disciplinarian. In 1961 Fr. Hartigan joined the faculty at Tolentine College, in Olympia Fields, Ill., and, while there, he completed his studies for a Doctoral degree in Education at Loyola University. During this time he also received the honor of being appointed Superintendent of the Augustinian Secondary School System in the Midwest. He returned to Mendel in 1964 as its principal and since has labored incessantly to make it one of Chicago's finest high schools.

ship during this past year.

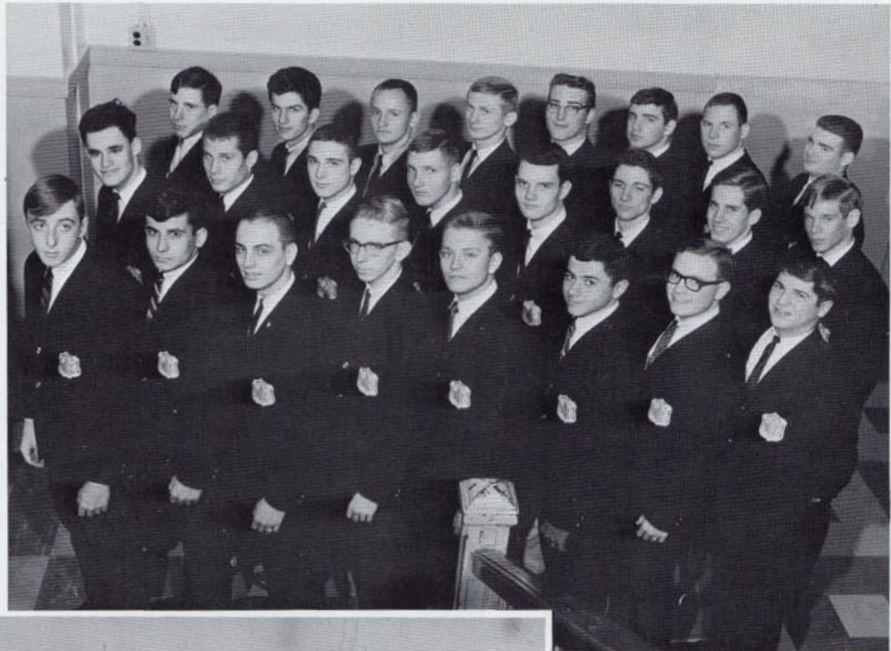

The National Honor Society

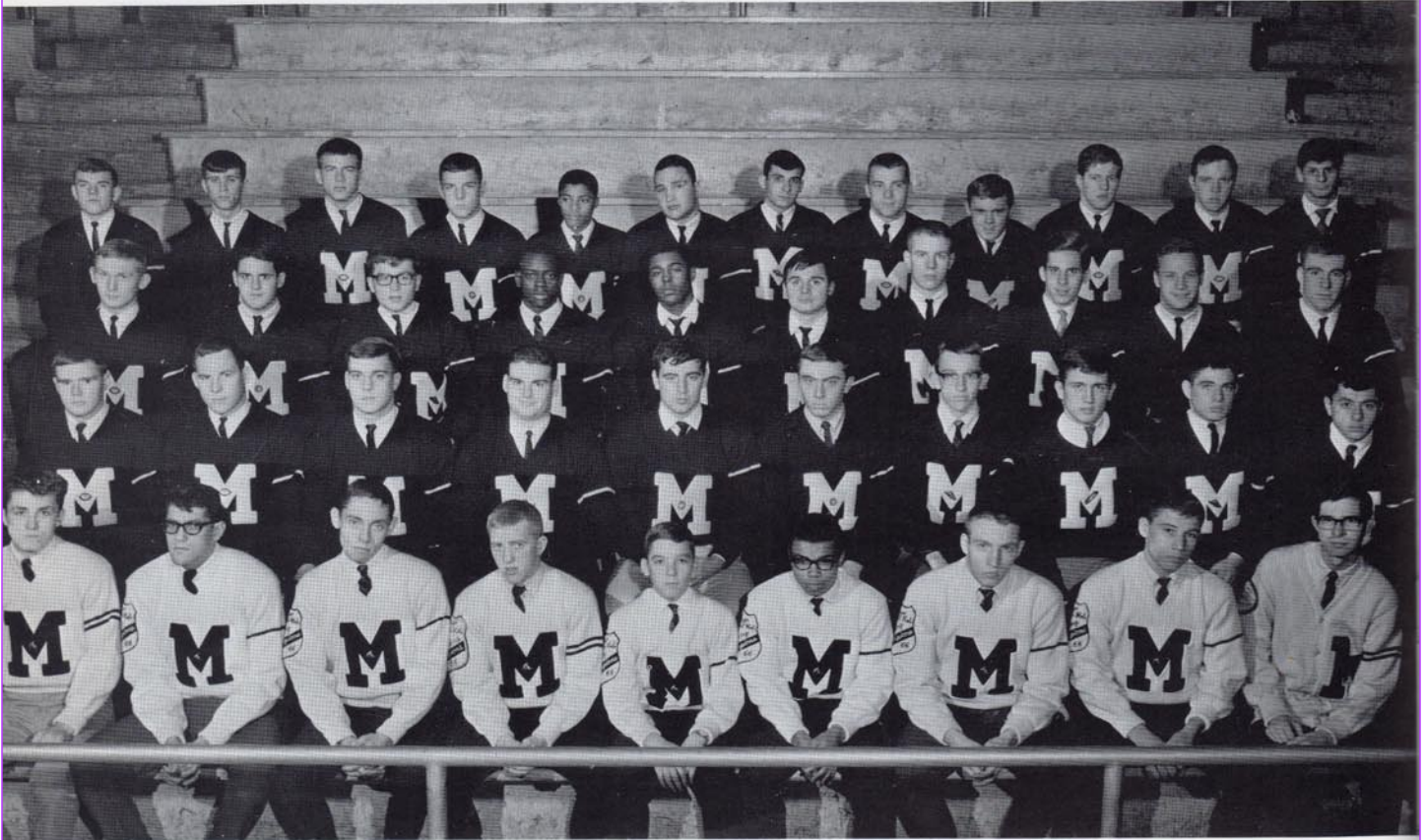

FENWICK: Going into enemy territory twelve point under-dogs with the knowledge that the Friars hadn't lost a homecoming game in 40 years, the Monarchs decided to "raise some eyebrows". They did just that, as they whipped the Fenwick squad 20 to 13, much to the surprise of everyone. Leslie, Gavin and Windauer were standouts in this superior effort.

ST. RITA: The Monarchs, riding high after whipping Carmel, were knocked off of cloud nine by a determined Rita squad. Falling behind early in the game, they were never able to gain enough momentum to dent an unusually tough Mustang defense. Fumbles, interceptions, and penalties were the order of the day as Mendel was routed 26 to 0.

ST. LAURENCE: Performing without the services of Rumpf, Arvia, and Klausner, the Monarchs nonetheless capped off the homecoming weekend with a 12 to 6 win over the Vikings. We would also like to thank The Walinger Studios Inc., Mendel's intrepid photographers. Many times they allowed us special consideration—for this we are most grateful.

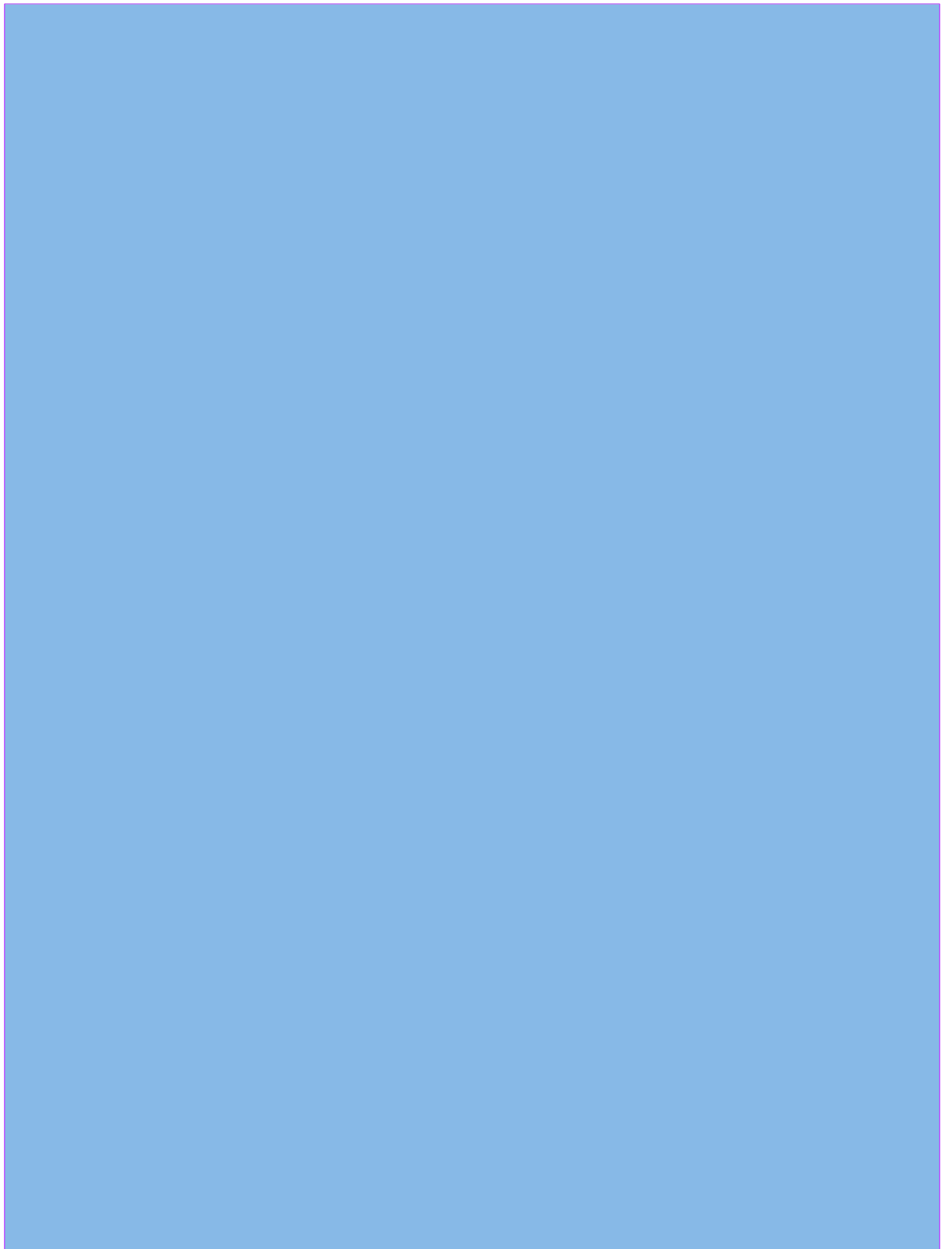
We would like to express our thanks to those Mendel students who willingly gave of their free time to make this yearbook possible.
