I would like to thank the Walinger Studios for their special consideration given to Mendel, which many of the excellent pictures in the book portray.



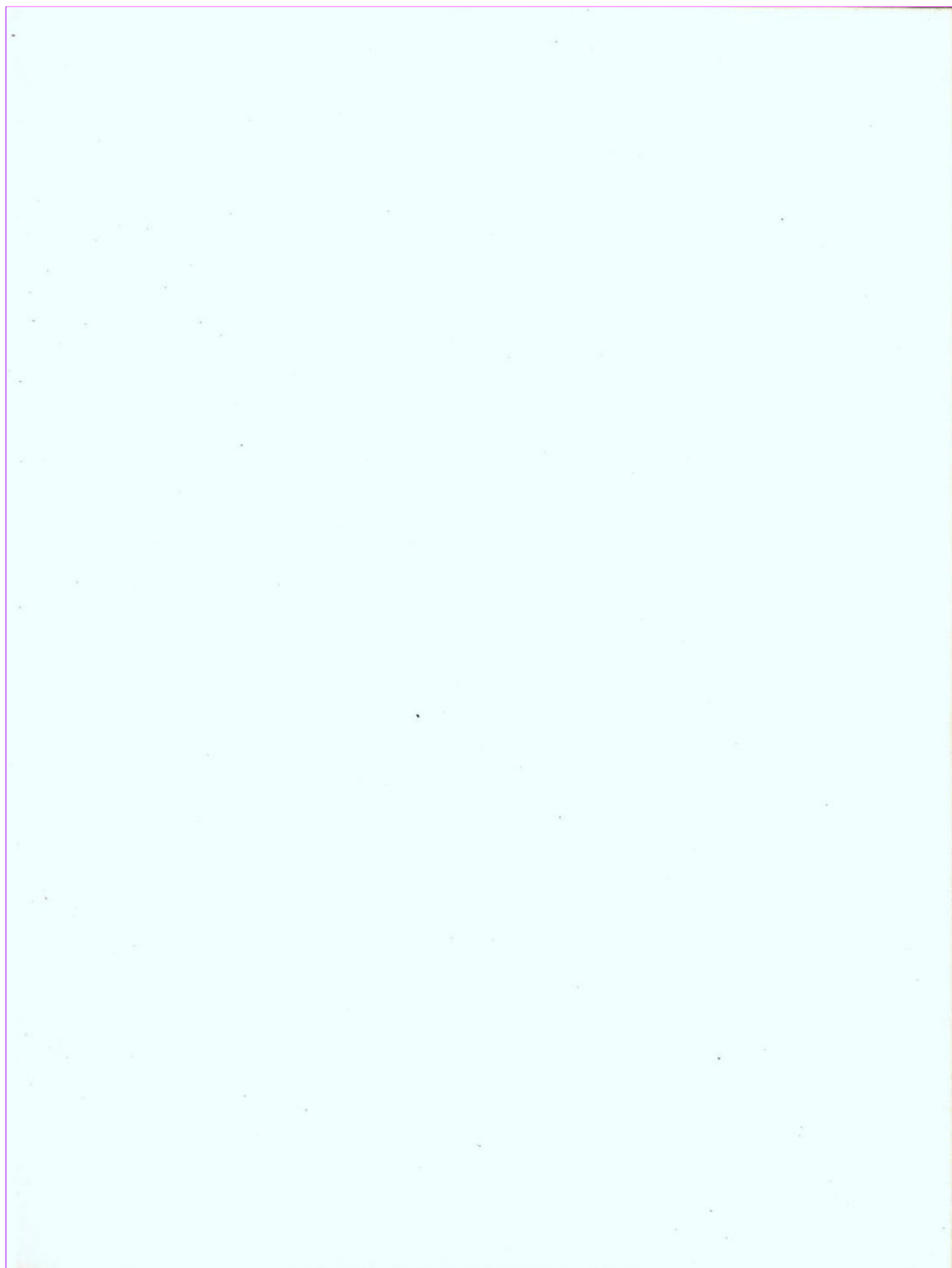
Lastly I would like to extend a "thank you" to the students and especially the teachers, for their time and special consideration given myself and the staff, in the past year.
