Chairman's Report-Golf Committee-Bill Johnson

Bill Johnson ('68) was introduced as the new Chairman of the Golf Committee. Bill is excited to serve as Chairman, and he expressed his desire to make the Golf Outing the best possible Golf Outing. He has lots of innovative ideas, and he looks forward to using them at the upcoming Golf Outing at Hickory Hills on July 10, 2024. He asked for every Board Member's support to optimize the Golf Outing on Wednesday July 10, 2024.

Bill is looking for more Members on the Golf Committee. He also wants Alumni to ask for donations at their favorite restaurants, bars retail stores, etc. Kelvin Lovely agreed that we need more people active on the Golf Committee. He has a couple of people in mind, and he will discuss them with Bill Johnson.

The cost at Hickory Hills will Be \$110 For Dinner & Golf in 2024. In 2023 The cost was \$100. Pat Regan explained that we made the \$1,000 deposit to Hickory Hills Golf Course for the 2024 Golf Outing.

David Ireland noted that his guests were extremely impressed with the gift items at the last Golf Outing.

Chairman's Report- Hall of Fame Committee-Tom Gavin

The Hall of Fame Committee remains problematic. Unlike the other Committees, the HOF Committee conducts its business independent of the Mendel Alumni Association Board of Directors. No one understood why this is true and all agreed that the HOF Committee should act similar to the other Alumni Association Committees.

Although the Board of Directors were asked to submit nominees to serve as Committee Chairman, no one has stepped up to serve as Committee Chairman since Ben McCall stepped down.

Tom Gavin continues to work with John Farris on Hall of Fame Committee issues. John Farris acts as the Secretary of the HOF Committee. However, all agreed that this Committee needs a leader. Tom Gavin said that the Committee currently has four Members: John Farris, Jack Gavin, Jim Riordan, and Ron Chambers.

Dennis Heitzmann asked why the Alumni Association Articles of Association Section 5 H-2 does not allow Board Members to participate in the selection of Hall of Fame Members or Hall of Fame Committee Members or Officers. Jack Gavin had to leave the Alumni Board so he could serve on the HOF Committee.

2) The Hall of Fame Committee shall be an independent committee charged with honoring outstanding Monarchs using criteria the Hall of Fame Committee shall set. The Hall of Fame Committee shall nominate and name its members, including the Chair using the criteria the Committee sets. To assure their independence the Board of Directors and its officers and board members shall not participate in selection of Hall of Fame members or Hall of Fame Committee members or officers.

No one could explain why this clause was included in the Articles of Association. David Ireland and Dennis Heitzmann suggested that this topic be discussed at the next BOD meeting and a motion be made to modify the wording in Section 5 H-2.

ACTION ITEMS: BOD Members to suggest improved wording for Section 5 H-2 Mike Dreznes to send Bill Johnson's contact details to all Board Members. UPDATE: After discussions with a few BOD Members, Mike Dreznes Mike Dreznes suggests that it be modified to read something like:

2) The Hall of Fame Committee shall be an independent committee charged with honoring outstanding Monarchs using criteria the Hall of Fame Committee shall set. The HOF Committee shall nominate, endorse, and select new members to the Mendel Hall of Fame, subject to approval by the Board.

Chairman's Report- Website Committee- Rick Zarr

Rick Zarr reported that the Policy Statement has been added to the Mendelchs.org website.

An announcement will be sent to Alumni encouraging them to include their businesses in the "SHOP MONARCHS DIRECTORY. The "SHOP MONARCH DIRECTORY" concept would generate more Monarch-to-Monarch discussions and help to grow Alumni businesses.

There would be no charge to be listed, and the following language would be used to protect the Alumni Association.

Companies, Services or Retail Stores shown on the "SHOP MONARCHS DIRECTORY" website are either owned by or employ a Mendel High School Alumnus. The contact shown for these organizations is the Mendel High School Alumnus.

The information, content and materials provided on the "SHOP MONARCHS DIRECTORY" website are for general informational purposes only. Information on this website may not constitute the most up to date details.

The website includes links to third-party websites. Such links are for the convenience of the reader, user, or browser. The Mendel Alumni Association does not endorse, nor recommend the contents of these third-party sites.

Alumni would be encouraged to donate to the Mendel Legacy Scholarship Program for the listing, but this would not be a requirement.

ACTION ITEMS: An Announcement introducing the SHOP MONARCHS DIRECTORY concept will be sent to all Alumni by October 1, 2023.

Rick Zarr once again encouraged all Board Members to contact Alumni friends and family members to get Mendel publications that can be scanned onto the Mendelchs.org website.

Chairman's Report-Membership Committee-Ron Dubin

Ron Dubin was unable to attend the meeting. Mike Dreznes again emphasized again how critical it is to locate Email addresses for Alumni since much of the correspondence and promotional materials for Alumni Events are sent through email.

Mike Dreznes explained the sad feeling when a woman responds to a phone message that he left by telling him that her husband passed away. One woman yelled at Mike and asked him why he did not call while her husband was alive because her husband loved Mendel but did not know about the Alumni Association. Mike said calls like that give him the incentive to make more calls.

Rich Williams continues to do an amazing job updating the Mendel Alumni Database for the classes from 1955 to 1964. Since June 20, 2023, Rich Williams has helped to find 354 more Deceased Monarchs and 142 more Email addresses for Alumni. Rich encouraged all Board Members to get actively involved to find more email addresses since email is the Alumni Association's typical mode of communication.

Mike Dreznes again asked each Board of Director every Board Member to review the database roster to see if they are aware of any deaths, change of contact details or email addresses of classmates, relatives, or friends. Mike Dreznes will send all Board of Directors the current database for Alumni. This database is not for public disclosure.

ACTION ITEMS: Mike Dreznes to send Board of Director Members the All-Class database by September 15, 2023. All BOD Members are to review the Alumni Roster Database and try to fill in as much missing

information as possible. UPDATE: Mike Dreznes sent the updated Alumni Directory to all Board Directors.

Chairman's Report-Veterans Committee-Andy Youpel

Andy Youpel reported that the November 11, 2023 Veterans Day Mass would be at either St. Cajetan's, St. Rita, St. Michaels, or St. Jude. The Event will be on a smaller scale than 2022. He will collaborate with his Committee and make an update at the next Board of Directors Meeting.

Andy asked all Board Members to consider helping with this Veterans Day Mass Event.

ACTION ITEMS: Andy Youpel to reconvene the Veterans Committee to develop a proposal for the 2024 Veterans Day Mass. This proposal will be presented to the Board of Directors at the next Board Meeting. UPDATE: Since November 11, 2023 is a Saturday, the parish churches have scheduled evening masses that day. In addition, they could be required to have a Funeral Mass on Saturday According to Andy Youpel, the preferred option now is St. Rita, and he will collaborate with Tom McCarthy to develop a program for the mass.

Chairman's Report-Scholarship Committee-Ron Smith

Ron Smith resigned from the Board of Directors the day before the meeting. Efforts are underway to find a new Chairman.

Mike Dreznes reported that the Scholarship Committee is trying to raise funds to pay for future Scholarships. He proposed a large Raffle that would be initiated immediately with the winner announced at the May 3, 2024 All-Class Reunion. Eric Rouse and Dennis Heitzmann suggested we use true Split The Pot Raffles rather than have designated prized.

Pat Regan emphasized that the Split the Pot raffle must be conducted at a specific event like a Golf Outing or a Class Reunion. Donations could only be accepted from Mendel Alumni.

The Board agreed that a Split the Pot Raffle with \$10 or \$20 tickets would be the preferred route and that these raffles be conducted whenever possible since they are great fundraisers.

Craig Larsen suggested selling bricks or tiles in Mendel Hall to raise funds for the Scholarship Program.

UPDATE: Eric Rouse has agreed to serve as the Chairman of the Scholarship Committee The Scholarship Committee is comprised of Eric Rouse, Craig Larson, Dennis Heitzmann, Pat Regan, Andy Youpel, Tom Gavin, Ron Smith, Kelvin Lovely, Bill Kushner, Bob Fioretti, Danny Randall, and Mike Dreznes Board Members were encouraged to notify Eric Rouse if they wanted to be on the Scholarship Committee.

OLD BUSINESS

Mendel Hall of Science Rededication Plans

Andy Youpel and Pat Regan are working close with St. Rita to find a permanent home for the Mendel Trophies and to pay respect to Gregor Mendel within the halls of St. Rita.

The hall that was called "Mendel Hall" will be renamed "The Mendel Hall of Science-Dedicated to the Mendel Catholic Prep Alumni Association," or words to that effect. The dedication ceremony would be scheduled for January 10, 2024 to honor Gregor Mendel's 200th Birthday. All of the St. Rita students, as well as Mendel Alumni will be invited to the dedication ceremony.


The plan is to include two trophy cases, the portrait of Gregor Mendel, a photo showing the fifteen Monarchs killed in Vietnam, a couple of posters telling the history of Mendel Catholic High School in a

twelve-foot by four-foot area that will be covered by a canopy. In a separate area, further down the Hall to the North, a mural describing Gregor Mendel's life will be laminated on the wall.

The biggest cost will be the trophy cases. St. Rita has offered to pay for one new trophy case if Mendel pays for one new trophy case. St Rita has some old trophy cases, but the cost to refurbish these cases to make them look good, and to put the required plexiglass on the cases makes them expensive compared to the two for one offer for the new cases since St. Rita will not pay for one of the refurbished cases.



The area for the Mendel Trophy cases will be as shown in the sketch below with "1" being a trophy case, "2" being the portrait of Gregor Mendel, "3" being the photo of the Monarchs killed in Vietnam, and "4" being the History of Mendel High School. David Ireland suggested a photo of Mendel High School be included.



The following trophies will be on display in the trophy cases: 1957 City Football Championship, 1957 Sun Times Football Championship, 1959 Basketball Championship, 1968 City Football Championship, 1968 Catholic League Championship, 1969 Football Championship South Section, and 1982 Illinois State Basketball Runner Up.

David Ireland asked if other trophies could be included, especially wrestling and track trophies. Pat Regan said all of the space in the cases would be filled with the seven trophies. However, he said it would be possible to rotate the trophies. Pat Regan asked for help locating wrestling and track trophies. It could also be possible to recreate some of these trophies.

Pat Regan showed the following summary regarding the cost for the Mendel Hall of Science:

St. Rita could purchase the cases to take advantage of their tax exempt status. John Mikenis made a motion to approve expenditures up to \$2,625 for Mendel Hall of Science. Gene Rouse seconded the motion, and the motion was approved unanimously.

Pat Regan suggested that a fundraiser could be conducted to offset the costs of the Rededication, and possibly add funds to the Mendel Alumni Association Legacy Scholarship Program.

Andy Youpel proposed that the Mendel Alumni Association sponsor two \$500 STEM Awards that would be granted in the form of a credit toward their senior year tuition at St. Rita high School. The winning students will demonstrate a proficiency in Science, Technology, Engineering and/or Math.

Eastside and Northwest Indiana "R.O.M.E.O." Update

Andy Youpel reported that the next R.O.M.E.O. Event would be at JJ Kelley's Restaurant and Pub located at 2455 Bernice Road in Lansing, Illinois from 11AM to 1 PM. Terry Lynch ('66) will be hosting this Event.

The cost to attend this Event will be \$25, and it will include a buffet lunch. A percentage of this revenue will be given to the Mendel Alumni Association Legacy Scholarship Fund.

Mike Dreznes and Rich Williams have accelerated their efforts to locate Alumni in Lansing, IL as well as the towns close to Lansing, including Munster, IN, Chicago Heights, IL, Calumet City, IL, Homewood, IL, South Holland, IL, and Dyer, IN. All Board Members were encouraged to attend this R.O.M.E.O. Event.

2024 All-Class Reunion Discussion

Mike Dreznes announced that the next All-Class Reunion will be held at Gaelic Park on May 3, 2024. The Classes of 1973 and 1974 will be honored for their 50th Anniversaries.



Mike Dreznes asked for volunteers to serve on an All-Class Reunion Committee.

NEW BUSINESS

St. Rita To Honor Mendel by Wearing Mendel Jerseys at a Home Basketball Game

New St. Rita Coach, Ross Burr offered to Andy Youpel and Pat Regan to have his St. Rita team wear Mendel Catholic jerseys at a basketball game this year. The Mendel Basketball teams could be honored at halftime and the Mendel Coaches (Mike Flaherty and Mike Mandarino) could sit on the bench during the game.

Mendel would purchase jerseys at a cost of about \$30 each. These jerseys could be used again next year.

Coach Burr needs to confirm with St. Rita and the Catholic League that he could do this. This could be a tremendous night for Mendel Alumni. It could include a reception before the game, a 50/50 Raffle and a wonderful photo opportunity.

Andy Youpel will follow up with Coach Burr and do what needs to be done to make this concept a reality.

David Ireland asked for a recap of the 2023 All-Class picnic. Pat Regan congratulated Derek Lot and his Picnic Committee on an excellent Picnic. It was a wonderful event.
