- 1. The Alumni Association made an insurance installment payment of \$249.
- 2. The Alumni Association made a test purchase of new white hats for \$183.09. They look great. They are white with the Mendel logon in powder blue with Navy lettering and a mesh back section. The latest quote for 120 hats is \$1,504, which is close to the cost we paid for the Navy-blue hats.
- 3. After much research, the Alumni Association leased a storage facility for Mendel artifacts and memorabilia such as the Mendel Gym Letters, golf sponsor signs, banners, and other items. The annual cost is \$721, and the unit size is 5" x 10'. It was time to concentrate all these items in a central and accessible location. The items in mentioned have moved between various Alumni homes, basements, and garages over many years. We plan to inventory and move the mentioned items sometime next week.
- 4. Mendel Science Hall -The Alumni Association paid \$920 to St. Rita for its share of one of the two showcases. The Alumni Association is still waiting for quotes for the Gregor Mendel Mural and printing of the Mendel School images and Mendel History.
- 5. The ROMEO event of 10/18/2023 was a very nice success. The results are not included in this report as Pat Regan was still reconciling items. Plus, the cash deposits were not made until earlier this morning and the CC charges have not yet been processed. A quick look shows the Alumni Association cleared \$340 and the Alumni Association also sold \$120 of hats and T-shirts.

6.Our current Cash Balance net of outstanding checks is \$19,869 and the Running Cash Balance is \$17,309. The primary difference is due to including the estimated costs for the Veterans and Mendel Science Hall Events which should, as has been the case for past Events, be offset by un-forecasted contributions and donations.

7. The activity for the year is a net cash usage of \$2,550 due primarily to the preliminary spending for the Mendel Science Hall, storage facility rent and replenishment of the T-shirt inventory.

Andy Youpel made the motion to accept the Treasurer's Report. John Franklin seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Committee Reports

Mike Dreznes was disappointed because not every Committee Chairman submitted a list of Members on his Committee so the information can be published on the Mendel website. Mike again asked the Committee Chairmen to send him a list of the members of their Committees ASAP.

Chairman's Report-Golf Committee-Bill Johnson

Bill Johnson was not at the meeting since he was on vacation. Tom Gavin reiterated that the Golf Outing would be held on Wednesday July 10, 2024 at Hickory Hills Country Club. Tom asked for every Board Member's support to optimize the Golf Outing. The Committee needs to finalize pricing so it can be posted on the website. The Golf Committee is still looking for more Members on the Golf Committee. Board Members are encouraged to make Golf Committee Membership recommendations to Bill Johnson.

Chairman's Report- Hall of Fame Committee-Tom Gavin

HOF Committee Secretary John Farris has been acting as the HOF Chairman pro tempore. The other Members of the HOF Committee are Jack Gavin, John Riordan, and Rod Chambers. Although these positions have not been filled, John Farris is confident that a Chairman, Vice-Chairman, and Secretary could be determined rather quickly.

After much discussion regarding Alumni Association Board Members being allowed to also be on the Hall of Fame Committee and the independence of the Hall of Fame Committee from the Alumni Association Board of Directors, it was proposed to modify the Alumni Association Articles of Association Section 5 Paragraph H-6 that reads:

6) The Hall of Fame Committee shall be an independent committee charged with honoring outstanding Monarchs using criteria the Hall of Fame Committee shall set. The Hall of Fame Committee shall nominate and name its members, including the Chair using the criteria the Committee sets. To assure their independence the Board of Directors and its officers and board members shall not participate in selection of Hall of Fame members or Hall of Fame Committee members or officers.

to read:

6. The Hall of Fame Committee shall be an independent committee charged with honoring outstanding Monarchs using criteria the Hall of Fame Committee shall set. The Hall of Fame Committee shall nominate, endorse, and select new Members to the Mendel Hall of Fame.

John Frankin made the motion to modify the Alumni Association Articles of Association Section 5 H-2 as proposed. Andy Youpel seconded the motion, and the motion was carried unanimously.

Mike Dreznes will update the Alumni Association Articles of Association by October 25, 2023...

Chairman's Report- Website Committee- Rick Zarr

Rick Zarr was on vacation. Mike Dreznes reported that the "SHOP MONARCHS DIRECTORY" is live on the website. Comments have been positive.



John Mikenis had suggested that the donations page be configured to allow reoccurring monthly donations. John Dreznes was able to set up this capability on the website. All Board of Director Members were encouraged to make monthly donations to the Scholarship Fund. To date John Mikenis and Mike Dreznes have signed up to make monthly donations.

Mike Dreznes encouraged all Board Members to contact Alumni friends and family members to get Mendel publications that can be scanned onto the Mendelchs.org website.

ACTION ITEMS: All BOD Members are encouraged to sign up to make Monthly Donations by November 1, 2023.

Chairman's Report-Membership Committee-Ron Dubin

Ron Dubin was unable to attend the meeting. Mike Dreznes emphasized the need to get Email addresses for Alumni to make them aware of the Alumni Association's existence and the Alumni Associations Events and Activities.

Rich Williams continues to do an incredible job locating addresses and phone numbers. Mike Dreznes is working with Rich Williams, and he makes phone calls to all Alumni with a phone number listed to get email addresses.. Some Alumni do not have access to email. They are being sent correspondence through US Mail.

Mike Dreznes currently has updated the database from the 1955 Class thru "MIKE SHAVER" in the Class of 1964. Bill Duffy has offered to contact his 1964 Classmates to get their email addresses.

Since June 20, 2023, Rich Williams has helped to find 425 more Deceased Monarchs and 201 more Email addresses for Alumni. Mike Dreznes encouraged all Board Members to get actively involved to find more email addresses since email is the Alumni Association's typical mode of communication.

Pat Regan presented the current status of the Mendel High School display area.

Mendel High School Display Area in Mendel Hall of Science




To take advantage of their tax-exempt status, St. Rita purchased the two trophy cases, and the Mendel Alumni Association will reimburse them for one of the cases.

The two flat screen TVs will show the photo of the Monarchs killed in Vietnam, as well as the History of Mendel High School and the Members of the Mendel Hall of Fame. The final configuration of the items on the screens is still under discussion. Other photos and items, such as sweaters and letters will be considered.

The following trophies are in hand and will be on display in the trophy cases: 1957 City Football Championship, 1957 Sun Times Football Championship, 1959 Basketball Championship, 1968 City Football Championship, 1968 Catholic League Championship, 1969 Football Championship South Section, and 1982 Illinois State Basketball Runner Up.

The Alumni Association continues to look for other trophies, especially Track and Wresting. It may be possible to recreate some of the missing trophies. Pat Regan said all of the space in the cases would be filled with the seven trophies. However, he said it would be possible to rotate the trophies.

In a separate area, further down the Hall to the North, Gregor Mendel's portrait and as well as a mural describing Gregor Mendel's life will be laminated on the wall.



The dedication ceremony is scheduled for January 10, 2024 to honor Gregor Mendel's 200th Birthday. All of the St. Rita students, as well as Mendel Alumni will be invited to the dedication ceremony.
