Minutes from December 15. 2023 BOD ZOOM Call Meeting Mike Dreznes

Mike Dreznes presented the Minutes from the December 15, 2023 Board Meeting. No one had any questions or comments regarding the ZOOM Call Minutes.

Bill Duffy made a motion to approve the minutes as submitted. Kelvin Lovely seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

<u>Treasurer's Report: Finance Committee Pat Regan</u>

Pat Regan presented the Financial Report as of February 19, 2023. Our current cash Balance stands at \$20,190 compared to a balance of \$19,845 as of 12/31/2024. I previously sent the Board the complete 2023 Financial Statements and supporting schedules. Since I did not receive any questions, I will not be making any comments on last years' results.

Items of note:

- 1. We have received 50 (\$3,445) paid registrations for the 2024 All Class Reunion. The Class of 1973 has accounted for 29 of the registrations. Of the total, we received 3 paid registrations in 2023.
- 2. We purchased 80 (\$1,750) Mendel Logo Polos that will be available as Donation Gifts at the All Class Reunion and other Events.
- 3. I have presented the Planned Corporate Cost as they will be paid Quarterly. In the near term the largest payment will be the initial D&O Insurance installment of \$963 to be paid in March.
- 4. We paid \$1,057 for the Mendel Science and Technology Hall Exhibit mostly for the small floor level showcase and the programming for the HOF/Veterans/ Mendel History on the vertical monitor.
- 5. I have started on the 2023 Form 990EZ Tax Return. There are some new reporting requirements.
- 6. I have filed the required Annual Report with the State of Illinois.

Chairman's Report-Golf Committee-Bill Johnson

Bill Johnson reported that the Golf Committee currently consists of Andy Youpel, Bill Duffy, Pat Regan, Tom Gavin, Rick Zarr, Don Goeppner, Kelvin Lovely, Tim Zimbauer, John Farris, John Knoebel, Mike Dreznes and Bill Kushner. He said that the Golf Outing Plan is in place, now it needs to be executed.

The Golf Outing will be held on Wednesday July 10, 2024 at Hickory Hills Country Club. Every Board Member is asked to get involved, either by playing, attending dinner, helping to work the event, or purchasing an ad in the Event Book.

Golf and Dinner will cost \$110 and have a purchase price of \$155. Dinner only will have a purchase price of \$55, and Hole Signs will have a purchase price of \$125.

Bill Johnson wants to pursue a major sponsor for the Golf Outing. He also wants to have other 'corporate' sponsors for the breakfast, bar, etc. He proposed \$1,500 for the "Mendelian (Grand) Sponsor. The Mendelian Sponsor will be shown on all Golf Outing publicity items. The Mendelian Sponsor will also have the opportunity to have a spot in the "Shop Monarchs Directory" on the website. UPDATE: Bob Aprati ('62) bought the Mendelian Sponsor for \$1,500 at the Western Suburb R.O.M.E.O.

Bill Johnson presented some golf promotional concepts prepared by John Knoebel. These included name for the golf carts that had the golfers name on one side and the Mendelian Sponsor on the other side. Bill Johnson and the Golf Committee will work with John Knoebel to implement these concepts.

Bill Johnson has photos of the Sponsor Hole Signs from previous Golf Outings. He will determine which signs need to be replaced. He will follow up with previous sponsors to convince them to be sponsors in 2024.

Bill Johnson recommends that the Alumni Association purchases a printer, Selfie Computer and cartridges that can be used at the Golf Outing to create 4"X 6" photos and/or 6" X 7" photos to sell to foursomes. Photos will be taken of each foursome at the start of the outing. These photos will be available at the end of the day for purchase. The cost will be about \$250. Bill is waiting for the approval to make the purchase. This printer can also be used at the Reunion and other Alumni events as well.



Chairman's Report- Hall of Fame Committee-Tom Gavin

Dennis Heitzmann submitted his resignation as Chairman of the HOF Chairman. John Farris provided the following report for the Alumni Association Board of Directors:

The deadline for May 2025 induction is December 31, 2024. Any existing nominations that were not selected will again be reviewed as has been past practice.

It is requested that a HOF Committee Member be given one to two minutes at the reunion to ask Hall of Fame members to stand and be recognized and to also direct the audience to the pages in the program that list all HOF members and the procedure/criteria for nomination and selection.


The information on the HOF in the proposed program book for the reunion has been reviewed, and the only changes would be committee membership and that will be updated on a timely basis.


Chairman's Report- Website Committee- Rick Zarr

From January 22, 2024 to February 18, 2024, the mendelchs.org site had seven hundred forty-five "hits."






All BOD Members were encouraged to sign up to make reoccurring Monthly Donations on the Mendel Website.

Chairman's Report-Membership Committee-Ron Dubin

Mike Dreznes once again emphasized the need to get Email addresses for Alumni to make them aware of the Alumni Association's existence and the Alumni Associations Events and Activities. Mike Dreznes explained that the goal of the Membership Committee is to locate good email addresses for 50% of the known living Alumni. Currently that number is at 34.8%.

All Board Members were sent the Alumni Roster Database and asked to review their information and fill in any missing details for all Alumni that they may know. They were asked to find email addresses since email is the Alumni Association's typical mode of communication with Alumni.


Since June 20, 2023, Rich Williams has helped to find 748 more Deceased Monarchs and 672 more Email addresses for Alumni. 2024 All-Class Reunion Discussion May 3, 2024



Board Members were strongly encouraged to take the lead and to register and pay for the All-Class Reunion as soon as possible. 2024 MAN OF THE YEAR

John W Boyer ('64)

John Boyer served as Dean of the University of Chicago from 1992 until 2023, making him the longest-tenured dean in the College's history.

Some of John Boyer's notable accomplishments include strengthening Alumni Relations, increasing funding for faculty chairs and student scholarship funds, and increasing the diversity of each successive class He also worked to get well-known scholars to teach undergraduate courses.

John focused on the development of study abroad programs. He was deeply involved in the establishment of the University of

Chicago Center in Paris, as well as many other Programs and Internships. As a result, study abroad rates have tripled since 1992.

John stepped down as Dean in 2023. He currently serves as Senior Advisor to the President and the Martin A. Ryerson Distinguished Service Professor at the University of Chicago. He is a Deserving Mendel Man of the Year!

Jack Vlazny ('61)



JACK VLAZNY MENDEL ALUMNI ASSOCIATION LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD By Jim Vlazny (Mendel '59)



Introduction: This is the story of my brother Jack Vlazny's fifty-five plus years of dedication and service to his Alma Mater Mendel Catholic High School, and to the Augustinians and others who ran the school. After reading it you will see why he well deserves to be recognized for his lifetime achievements on behalf of his high school, and why he has earned the affectionate title of "Mr. Mendel".

In the Beginning: Jack entered Mendel as a freshman in the fall of 1957.



This was a great time to be a Monarch since it was the year that Mendel won the City Football Championship in dramatic fashion, with a forty-one yard touchdown on the last play of the game. Jack and several of his classmates also had older brothers at Mendel, and this made it easy for them to fit in and enjoy their four years at the new school in the old Pullman neighborhood. Mendel drew students from all over the South and Southeast Sides, and one of the interesting features of this diverse student body was that Jack and his classmates got to know and rub shoulders with young men of different backgrounds, cultures, and ethnicity. All of these factors contributed to make Jack's four years at Mendel a very memorable experience, and they help to explain his devotion to the school

Ron Dubin made the motion to change the "Mendel Alumni Association Lifetime Achievement Award" to the "Jack Vlazny Lifetime Achievement Award." Terry Gainer seconded the motion, and the motion was unanimously approved.

Bob Lopez ('73) and Dr. Dan Rowen ('74) have agreed to act as the spoke person for their respective classes.
