### **MINUTES**


### President Tom Gavin Called the Meeting to Order at 7:04 PM

Pat Regan was not able to attend the meeting due to personal reasons. Mike Dreznes presented the Financial Report as of October 8, 2024, on Pat's behalf.


Mike showed two attachments. The first attachment showed the Year-to-Date Summary as of 10/6/2024. Our Bank Cash Balance stands at \$38,726 and our Projected 12/31/2024 Running Cash Balance stands at \$35,388, This did not change much from the last projection

These are the significant items since our last meeting:

1. We made the 3rd installment of the D&O Insurance. There is 1 more payment to be made in November.

2. Our Storage Facility costs have increased as our promotional first year deal expired in October. we will see a \$300 annual increase.

3. We paid St. Rita for the First Annual Gregor Mendel Science and Technology Awards (2 @ \$500/each).



Pat Regan prepared a Second Attachment labeled Cost Coverage.

This preliminary analysis shows the estimated Cost Commitments for the Annual Events and other related spending for 2025. This does not include any receipts from Events nor donations Sources-just the cost of operating the Association and conducting the expected Events in 2025.

John Mikenis made the motion to accept the Treasurer's Report. Eric Rouse seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.


### Coach Joe Magee Induction Into the Chicago Catholic League Hall of Fame

Tom Gavin explained the Catholic League Hall of Fame Application for Coach Joe Magee has been submitted.

When Coach Magee is inducted into the 2025 HOF Class on May 1, 2025, his widow, Maureen will use the occasion to present the ball used in the 6-0 Prep Bowl Victory over Calumet High School in 1957 to allow it to be displayed in Mendel Hall at St. Rita High School.

All Monarchs, especially Monarchs who played for Coach Magee will be invited to make the induction dinner an incredibly special night in Mendel Lore. The goal is to fill a great number of tables at the induction.

Mike Dreznes showed a plaque from the New World in 1957 naming Coach Magee the All-American Catholic Prep Coach of the Year in 1957. John Mikenis found this plaque on eBay! This plaque also will be displayed in the Mendel Hall of Fame at St. Rita.



Mike Dreznes also announced that the application for Mike O'Hare's ('70) Induction into the Catholc League Hall of Fame also had been submitted.

The goal is to have good email addresses for 65% of the living Alumni. We are currently at 58.2%. When the campaign started in June of 2023, we only had 23% of the email addresses for living Alumni.

Some classes are doing very well (green highlighted classes), and some classes need a "Champion" to locate missing Classmates (red highlighted classes). The Class of 1976 was called out and challenged to find contact details on Classmates to have good emails for at least 40% of the living Classmates. The 1976 Class is the only Mendel graduation Class under 40! Mike asked for everyone's help with this critical assignment.

It is unrealistic to expect an Alum to attend a Mendel activity if he does not know about the event. Using emails is the most effective option we have to raise awareness of the Alumni Association and our events and activities. We need more email addresses!

### Chairman's Report-Legacy Award Committee-Eric Rouse

The Mendel Legacy Award Committee is comprised of Chairman Eric Rouse, Craig Larson, David Milton, John Wilson, Dennis Heitzmann, Don Triveline, Pat Regan, Andy Youpel, Tom Gavin, Ron Smith, Kelvin Lovely, Bob Fioretti, Danny Randall, John Franklin, and Mike Dreznes. Eric Rouse and Craig Larson agreed to coordinate the 2025 Legacy Award Campaign. Craig Larson offered to be the contact person to receive all the Applications and Essays. He will then distribute them to the Legacy Award Committee for judging.

i Pat Regan noted that will be able to present up to \$7,000 in Scholarships in 2025, compared to \$6,000 this year.



Mike Dreznes reminded everyone that the 2025 Mendel Legacy Award is open to any child, grandchild or great grandchild of a Mendel High School Alum who is a senior in high school (2025 Graduating Class.) The submittal deadline is March 15, 2025.

### Chairman's Report-Hall of Fame Committee-J.C. Crane

J.C. asked all Board Members to send nominations for Mendel Alumni Association for the HOF Class of 2025. He emphasized that not every application is approved for induction. The Mendel HOF Members are the best of the best.

He stated that the Committee had received three complete applications to date. The deadline is December 31, 2024. The HOF Induction Ceremony will be Saturday May 24, 2025 at 10:30 AM at St. Rita.

He noted that Andre Banks, Mike Hogan and Tony Daniel were inducted into the Chicago Catholic League Hall of Fame (CCLHOF), but not the Mendel Hall of Fame. The Board agreed that Induction into the CCLHOF should automatically qualify the individual for induction into the Mendel HOF. JC noted that this issue will be addressed by the Mendel HOF Committee.

(UPDATE-Mike O'Hare ('70) who is being considered for Induction into the CCLHOF also is not a Member of the Mendel HOF John Mikenis initated an application for Michael O Hare for the Mendel HOF.

John Mikenis and J.C.Crane announced that the H.O.F. Committee is planning to intrduce "Mendel Den of Honor" as a subset of the Mendel H.O.F.



### They presented the criteria for Induction below:

#### Proposal:

In collaboration with the Mendel Hall of Fame Committee and the Mendel Alumni Association, we are excited to introduce a potential concept to periodically honor our Championship Teams from our 37-year history. This recognition will be branded as the "Monarchs Den of Honor".

The sole criterion for recognition in "The Den" is for the team to have won a minimum of a League Championship.

Our goal with this initiative is to raise awareness of the Mendel Hall of Fame and encourage individual Alumni applications for potential membership.

#### Potential Procedure:

Teams can be nominated no more frequently than quarterly.

Modest preliminary research on the web will need to be conducted to gather background information on the team.

A brief paragraph about the team will be written, which can then be submitted for publication on the AA website. This paragraph will include a link to the HOF page and encourage individuals to apply.

Volunteers from both the AA Board of Directors and the HOF Committee will be asked to participate in this effort.

# The Board agreed that, if this concept is accepted by the H.O.F. Committee, the 1957 Mendel Football team should be the first team inducted into the "DEN."






Mike Dreznes showed the Mendel Alumni Veterans killed in Vietnam, as well as the Mendel Men killed in the Line of Duty as First Responders.




All Board Members were strongly encouraged to attend this Mass.

### Website Committee-Rick Zarr

The Mendel Alumni Association continues to get rave reviews for its website. Rick Zarr, John Fanning and John Dreznes were thanked for their efforts.

John Dreznes and John Fanning are working on "fixes' to speed up the website and to prevent "glitches" that can cause the site to crash.

Mike Dreznes has reached out to Bernie Tafoya ('75) so ask him to record interviews with Mendel Authors. To date, Mike and Bernie have not connected.

### **BOD Members Financial and Personal Commitment**

### Second Half of 2024 and 2025 Calendar of Events-John Mikenis

The following schedule of events was presented to the Board.

John Mikenis expressed concern that too many Mendel Alumni Association events were scheduled too close to each other.
