Minutes from February 25, 2025 BOD ZOOM Call Meeting Mike Dreznes

Treasurer's Report: Finance Committee Pat Regan


Pat Regan noted that the Alumni Association had raised \$215,000 in the past four years.


Our total Book Cash Balance stands at \$34,518 of which \$5,354 is in our Chase Bank Account and \$29,163 is in our new Stifel Money Market Account (MMA). We opened the MMA in early January 2025 with a beginning investment balance of \$40,000. To date, we have earned \$513 of


Using funds from the MMA we disbursed \$9,350 for 11 Legacy Awards in April. There are still eight checks totaling \$6,600, which are still un-cashed. We should be very pleased with such Outstanding Results!

The Costs and Expenses highlighted in Yellow are to be paid in the future. These include \$2,000 for the 5/24/2025 HOF Event and Corporate Costs of \$3,018 for Insurance, Web Site fees and Storage. This brings our Projected Running Cash Balance to \$29,455. Kelvin Lovely asked that the All-Class Picnic costs be included in the next report.

Our HOF donations have been slow totaling only \$438 to date.








John Mikenis made a motion to approve the report as submitted. Bob Lopez seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Pat Regan announced that he would not be renewing his Treasurer BOD position after July 31, 2025. Pat was thanked for his incredible dedication and service to the Alumni Association.

Locating Alumni Status-Mike Dreznes

Mike Dreznes presented the following chart that showed the progress that has been made over the past twenty-three months to locate missing Alumni. We cannot expect Alumni to participate in the Mendel Alumni activities if they are not aware of them.



Some classes are doing very well (green highlighted classes), and some classes need a "Champion" to locate missing Classmates (red highlighted classes). Mike Dreznes called out the 1979 Class, who have email addresses for less than 38% of the living Classmates. Mike Dreznes promised to send out the All-Class Master Roster to all Board Members.

Mike thanked Rich Williams, Derek Lott and Ron Dubin for their efforts to find missing Alumni.

Mike Dreznes offered to send an updated roster to all Board Members, and he asked all Board Members to review the contact details for themselves, as well as friends, family, and other Classmates, and to notify Mike Dreznes of any necessary changes. The goal is to have good email addresses for 65% of the living Alumni. We are currently at 60.3%. When the campaign started in June of 2023, we only had 23% of the email addresses for living Alumni.


Website Committee Report-Rick Zarr







<u>Plans to Recognize First Responder Richard Barth ('67) Killed in Line of Duty-Mike Dreznes</u>

Richard Barth ('67) was a Downers Grove Patrolman. He was killed in the line of duty on March 18, 1974 after only two years on the force. Barth Pond in Patriots Park in Downers Grove is named after him. Every year the Downers Grove Police Department honors the memory of Officer Barth in Patriots Park on May 17.



The Downers Grove police were not receptive to a ceremony to honor Richard Barth that included the Mendel Alumni Association. The family of Richard Barth also would prefer not to have a memorial service for Richard Barth.



A Moment of Pride: St. Rita, Mendel, Celebrate Pope Leo XIV's Augustinian Roots and Chicago Legacy




Dear Mendel Catholic High School Alumni and Friends,

With hearts full of joy, we join the global Catholic community in celebrating the election of Cardinal Robert Francis
Prevot as Pope Leo XIV on May 8, 2025. As the first American pope, his historic ascent to the papeo; is a moment
of immense pride for Chicagin's South Sed and the Augustinian family that happed our beloved Mendle Catholic High
School, While not a Mendel alumnus, Pope Leo XIV's deep Augustinian roots, upbringing in Dolton, early ministry at
St. Rita of Cascia High School, and familial ties to Mendel through his brothers, Louis Prevost (Class of Y9) and John
Persent (Class of 172) responsate profused with our community reflection the values that differed our schools liscone.

The visits to the Mendelchs.org website increased by 800% when this story was published.

Due to the close connections between Pope Leo XIV and Mendel (Two brothers attended Mendel, Mother was the librarian and President of the Mother's Club, plus Pope Leo is an Augustinian,) it was proposed that Pope Leo XIV be named an Honorary Mendel Alumnus. Kelvin Lovely read the proclamation. Terry Gainer made the motion to name Pope Leo as an Honorary Mendel Alumnus. David Ireland seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.





Mike Dreznes suggested that the Mendel Alumni Association considers being involved in efforts to turn St Mary of the Assumption Church into a shrine for Pope Leo XIV. This was Pope Leo XIV's church when he was growing up in Dolton, Illinois. Father Tom Griffin offered to notify the Augustinian Provincial of the Alumni Association's interest in the development of this shrine.

John Mikenis suggested that the Pope would prefer the money to be given to the poor rather than be spent to create the shrine. Mike Dreznes emphasized that the Alumni Association may have a leadership role, but would not have a financial interest. SUBSEQUENT DISCUSSIONS SHOWED MORE INTEREST IN A SHRINE AT MENDEL HALL AT ST. RITA. MORE DISCUSSIONS TO FOLLOW.




Jack Vlazny Resolution- Mike Dreznes

Articles of Association Addendum- John Mikenis

John Mikenis noted that the Mendel Alumni Association Articles of Association needed clarification regarding the functions of the Executive Board. He proposed that the following Addendum be added to the Mendel Alumni Association Articles of Association:

The Board shall set policy for the Association. The Board Chair shall be empowered to set policy agenda for the Officers between meetings to then be submitted to the Board for ratification. The Board of Directors shall consist of 1) The President, who shall execute policy. 2) The Vice President shall act in the President's absence and shall replace the President if he leaves during his term of office. 3) The Secretary shall take minutes of Board meetings, and distribute same. 4) The Treasurer shall be in-charge of the Association's fiscal affairs, and may make expenditures consistent with the Approved Budget.

The Executive Board/Committee shall be composed of the Board Chair, the President, the Vice President, the Secretary, and the Treasurer. The Executive Board shall have the power to exercise all the powers of the Board between Board meetings in conjunction and with Board review and approval. Further they shall cause strategic, long -range planning to be done; shall request preparation of an annual budget for approval by the full Board and other duties as the Board of Directors may prescribe from time to time. Action may be taken by an affirmative vote of a majority of Executive Board/Committee members, provide a quorum is present. Executive Board/Committee actions shall be reported in full to the Board of Directors at its next regular meeting.

Mike Frigo made a motion to add this addendum. Bill Duffy seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

RING OF HONOR Proposal-Mike Dreznes

The Mendel Veterans and First Responders who died in the Line of Duty deserve to be recognized for their valor and commitment. Therefore, the Mendel Alumni Association Veterans and First Responder Committee announced the creation of the "Ring of Honor" to remember Mendel Men who gave up their lives in Military Service or as First Responders.

This "Ring of Honor" will be introduced at the Mendel Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony on May 24, 2024. A more detailed explanation of the concept will happen at the Mendel Alumni Association Golf outing on July 25, 2025.

Pat Regan made a motion to approve the Veterans and First Responder Committee's request to create the Ring of Honor. Tom Gavin seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
