Minutes from June 24, 2025 BOD ZOOM Call Meeting Mike Dreznes

Mike Dreznes presented the Minutes from the June 24, 2025, Board Meeting. No one had any questions or comments regarding the ZOOM Call Minutes.

Rick Zarr made a motion to approve the minutes as submitted. Terry Gainer seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Treasurer's Report: Finance Committee Pat Regan

Pat Regan announced that the major financial activity was the 2025 Golf Outing, which set a new record-achieving a net contribution of \$14.4k.

The only other major item is that we secured Crime Insurance, which was paid in July-premium of \$758. This coverage is typical for Associations like ours and protects our Funding that has increased significantly in 2023-2025.


Given our present Cash Balance, with \$34Kk in our Money Markey account we might want to consider putting some of those funds into a 6 month CD. This would allow us to lock in a rate of 4.10 - 4.15% as it would seem that Money Market rates will probably decrease in the near future. UPDATE: The Board agreed that Pat Regan should invest \$20,000 in a CD with Russ Petrizzo.

Pat Regan presented a new Report comparing our YTD Results to the Annual Plan as of 7/31/2025. With the conclusion of the Golf Outing ,we are pretty much past all the Major Events for 2025.

Events open for the balance of the year are Vets Day, Romeo's and Xmas Party, which usually perform near break- even. The other Major considerations are: Donation to Augustinians-ie. Health and Well Being Care. We gave \$7,000 in 2023.

Legacy/Gregor Mendel Award Collections are more seasonal as we mostly gain these receipts in non-Reunion years around Thanksgiving- Christmas time frame. We garnered \$6,350 in the Fall of 2024.



John Mikenis made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report and Bill Duffy seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

New Board of Directors August 1, 2025 Configuration -Kelvin Lovely Vote/Installation of New Board Members for 8/1/25 to 7/31/28 Term

Eric James was presented to the Board as a possible replacement for John Wilson for a three-year term starting on August 1, 2025. The other Board Members whose terms expired on July 31, 2025 agreed to extend their terms for an additional three years until July 31, 2028.


Pat Regan was named Assistant Secretary as well as Treasurer.

Locating Alumni Status-Mike Dreznes

Mike Dreznes presented the following chart to show the progress made since June 20, 2023 to locate missing Alumni. He emphasized that we cannot expect Alumni to participate in the Mendel Alumni activities if they are not aware of them. We need email addresses!



Some classes are doing very well (blue highlighted classes), and some classes need a "Champion" to locate missing Classmates (red highlighted classes).

Mike thanked Rich Williams, Derek Lott and Ron Dubin for their efforts to find missing Alumni.

The goal is to have good email addresses for 65% of the living Alumni. This is the first time we reached 61%. When the campaign started in June of 2023, we only had 23% of the email addresses for living Alumni.

Hall of Fame Committee Report -J.C. Crane

J.C. Crane asked for 2026 Mendel HOF Nominations. The deadline for applications is December 31, 2025. Mike Dreznes also asked for 2026 Chicago Catholic League HOF nominees. Don Ledin was suggested. 
All Board Members were asked to donate goods, services or cash to be used for raffle items or giveaways. All but two Board Members complied with this request.

Based on the survey responses & the discussions at the Golf Committee Recap Meeting & the discussion at the Board of Directors Meeting, the following suggestions were made for 2026:

Suggestions from Golf Committee Meeting for 2026

Clearly show that a hot dog and a beer are included in the price.

Reduce the number of Raffle Prizes to simplify awarding and distribution of prizes. Combine items to make each raffle item worth at least \$150.

To promote the raffle, announce the fact that raffle and prizes have a total value of \$XXX.

Include a free raffle ticket with any shirt sale. (Possibly 1 raffle ticket for every \$15 spent on merchandise)

We must get our Class Reps more involved to increase attendance from their Classmates

Delegate tasks to volunteers and put that person in charge, such as sales of the Split the Pot or Raffle Tickets

Do not wait until the end of the event to sing the Fight Song

Consider taking photos inside before foursomes leave for their first tee.

How much money did we receive from Dixon Golf?

All agreed that one person needs to be the Golf Committee Chairperson. However, should we have assistants for the Committee Chairman?

Start with the prior year foursomes and see who's returning

Get the class reps involved for foursome recruitment, hole sign and raffle prize solicitation. Get out and ask for hole sponsors and raffle prizes.

At check-in golfers should get a goody bas (golf balls, tees, ball marker, divot tool, sun screen, snack bar, etc.) as well give all golfers name tags.

Return to longest drive and continue with closest to pin. Winning foursome gets \$200 and 2nd place \$100.

No outside involvement (games). We need forward tees. These guys are getting old & just don't hit the ball far A shorter course? Better rates? I know everyone likes Hickory Hills but this should be looked at in the future.

A second opinion of sorts.

Look at our pricing structure for golf/dinner and dinner. Some people think that everyone has a lot of money to spend but that's not necessarily true for some of the Alumni.

The later Mendel classes must get involved to keep these events going.

Class of 1975 50th Anniversary Celebration Report-Eric Rouse

Approximately sixty members of the 1975 Class met at Gwendolyn Brooks High School in the morning of Satuday June 7, 2025. They then went to Baroccos Pizza for dinner. The organizing committee did an excellent job planning ond implementing the event.

Eric Rouse requested that the 2026 Golf Outing be held the same weekend as the All-Class Reunion where the Class of 1975 will be Honored Guests for their 50th Anniversary.

Catholic League HOF Monarch Nominations Status-Mike Dreznes

Mike Dreznes reminded the Board that the Chicago Catholic League Hall of Fame Nominations must be submitted by February 6, 2026.

It was suggested that Don Ledin be considered. The Board needs someone to work with Don Ledin to confirm his interest and to initiate his application. Don Ledin is in the Mendel HOF.

Pope Leo XIV was mentioned as another Chicago Catholic League Hall of Fame Nominee.

Mike Dreznes offered to discuss this possibility with Tom McCarthy at St. Rita High School.

NEW BUSINESS

Gregor Mendel Birthday Donation to Retired Augustinians

Gregor Mendel's birthday is July 20, 2025. The Board proposed presenting \$5,000 for the retired Augustinians. This was already in the budget and it could become an annual tradition on Gregor Mendel's birthday. Pat Regan made the motion to present the \$5,000 to the Augustinians. Terry Gainer seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously.

<u>Proposal to Review of the Articles of Association - Kelvin Lovely</u>

Kelvin Lovely advised that he is reviewing the existing Mendel Alumni Association Articles of Association. He will present his proposal for a rewrite at the first Board Meeting in 2026.

Pope Leo XIV Shrine in Gregor Mendel Hall at St. Rita-Mike Dreznes

Mike Dreznes reported that he talked to Tom McCarthy who agreed that a shrine to Pope Leo XIV would be a good idea. He proposed that the shrine be in the St. Rita Chapel Vestibule, and the background be a collage of the Pope. More details to follow.

Terry suggested a Boat Cruise to honor the Midwest Augustinians, There are 56 Midwest Augustinians. Fr. Tom Griffin offered to help to coordinate the cruise. More details to follow.

UPDATE: A conference call is scheduled for Tuesday August 12 to discuss plans for this cruise. This will <u>NOT</u> be a fundraiser. Terry Johnson is donating the boat and the open bar. The Alumni Association will supply wrapped sandwiches from Subway or Jimmy Johns, or something similar.

This will <u>NOT</u> be used as a fundraiser for the Pope's Shrine at St. Rita. However, we can use the cruise as the opportunity to announce the Shrine. We could call the Cruise "The Augustinian River Cruise" or something like that.

The boat will be the Fort Dearborn, which can easily accommodate 100 passengers. It will be a two-hour cruise down the Chicago River. The boat leaves from a dock that is just west of Navy Pier. There will NOT be anyone narrating the architect tour. This is designed to be purely a social event.


We should consider hiring a bus or an Uber to get the Augustinians from Crown Point to the dock.

Terry Johnson suggests we have the cruise at 5 PM on a Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday in early September. I suggest September 9, 10 or 11. The St. Rita Award ceremony is at 9:30 on September 10. We could invite the two winners to join us on the cruise.

It was suggested that each Augustinian be allowed to bring a guest, if he or she desires. We should also invite the Board of Directors to attend as cruise hosts. Comments are welcomed.

Discovery of Sixteenth Monarch killed in Vietnam-Andy Youpel

Andy Youpel explained that he was notified by a Mendel Alum that we were not including James Sachaschik ('67) in our list of Veterans who were killed in Vietnam. Research verified that James Sachashik did die in Vietman on February 24, 1970 and he is on the Vietnam Wall in Washington D.C. He is the 16th Monarch killed in Vietnam.

The 1975 Class will be Honored Guests (50 Years), along with the 1976 Class (50 Years) as well as the 1955 Class (Our First 70 Year Class) at the 2026 Mendel Alumni Association All-Class Reunion. The 1965 and 1966 Classes (60 Years) and the 1985 and 1986 Classes (40 Years) will Special Guests.

Mike Dreznes asked for volunteers to join the organizing committee for the All-Class Reunion in 2026. Bob Lopez had previously offered to serve. Mike Dreznes had sent an email blast to the 1975 and 1976 Class to ask them to create an Organizing Committee. Only Eric Rouse ('75) and William Marshall ('76) responded positively.

Mike Dreznes hoped that some 1975 and 1976 Classmates step up to be the leaders for this Reunion.

Mike Dreznes expressed a real concern that the known email addresses for the 1975 Class and the 1976 Class are among the lowest of all classes. (50% for 1975 and 44% for 1976) This could create notification problems. He asked for help from the Board to coordinate this Reunion.

Logical choices for the event are either Gaelic Park or Hickory Hills Golf Course. The last Reunion was held on May 3, 2024 at Gaelic Park.
